



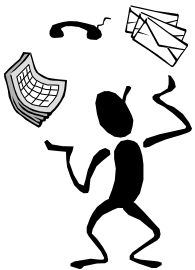

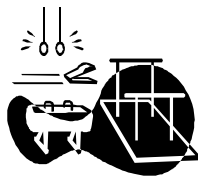
Tuition

June tuition is **due** on June 1st. There will be a \$50 late fee to child care accounts and \$20 late fee for classes not paid by the 5th of the month. Your child will not be allowed to participate in our program if the full tuition is not received by June 10th, including the late fee. A two week notice is needed to terminate any class or day care.

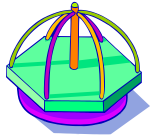
Learning Center

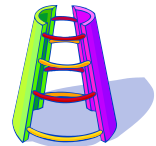
